Publication

1. AN ACT to provide certain rights to persons with disabilities; to provide for the promotion and protection and full and equal enjoyment of the rights; to facilitate the enforcement of the rights; to eliminate discrimination on the basis of disability; to provide for the welfare and rehabilitation of persons with disabilities; to provide for the registration of persons with disabilities; to establish the National Commission on Disabilities; and for connected purposes.

Introduction and First Reading

2. The Bill was introduced in the National Assembly and read for the first time on 19th November, 2009.

Second Reading

3. The Bill was read for the second time and debated on 26th November, 2009.

4. Following its second reading, the Bill was committed by the National Assembly to a Special Select Committee for consideration.

6.2.1 The Chairman thanked all the Members and staff of the Committees Division and noted that with the examination of the Bill, Guyana has been made to look a little more humane to the cause of the disabled and, further posited that the Bill sought to change the way in which persons with disabilities were treated.
