MISCELLANEOUS ENACTMENTS (AMENDMENT) BILL 1974

A BILL

Intituled

An Act to amend and repeal certain enactments.

A.D. 1974 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title and commencement 1.(1) This Act may be cited as the Miscellaneous (Enactments) (Amendment) Act 1974.

Cap. 85:05 (2) The amendment to the Post Office Savings Bank Act as mentioned in the schedule, shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st August, 1973.

(3) Section 3 shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st August, 1973.

Amendment of enactments. 2. The enactments specified in the first column of the schedule shall be amended to the extent set out in the second column thereof.

Repeal of Chapter 82:02. 3. The Bill of Entry (In Aid of Defence) Levy Act is hereby repealed.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to effect a miscellany of amendments to varied enactments and to repeal the Bill of Entry (In Aid of Defence) Levy Act. The repeal of that Act is a measure by Guyana towards implementing the obligations undertaken under Article 15 of the Treaty establishing the Caribbean Economic Community.

In amending the Post Office Savings Bank Act, the limitation imposed by the proviso to subsection (1) of section 11 of that Act to the effect that sums on deposit may not wholly be invested in Guyana will no longer apply.

The amendment relating to the Labour Act would enable the Agricultural Assessors of the Ministry of Labour to exercise similar powers conferred by that Act upon Labour Officers.
