AN ACT to amend the Public Health Ordinance.

A.D. 1976 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. Cap. 145 1953 Ed. 1. This Act, which amends the Public Health Ordinance, may be cited as the Public Health (Amendment) Act 1976.

Amendment of section 135 (5) of the Principal Ordinance.

Cap. 28:01.

2. Subsection (5) of section 135 of the Public Health Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "Subject to sections 299 and 300 of the Municipal and District Councils Act and to any certification to the contrary under the hand of the Minister, no" for the word "No" at the beginning of that subsection.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend the Public Health Ordinance to bring it into conformity with the Municipal and District Councils Act and to allow for a lot of land to be subdivided into less portions than quarter lots.
