1. This Act, which amends the Shipping Casualties (Investi- Short title and comgation and Prevention) Act, may be cited as the Shipping Casual- mencement ties (Investigation and Prevention) (Amendment) Act 1978.

2. The Principal Act is hereby amended by the insertion Amendment in section 4(a) immediately after the word "coasts" — 4 of the Principal

- (a) in sub-paragraph (i), the words ", in inland rivers Act. or navigable waters, "; and
- (b) in sub-paragraphs (ii) and (iii), of the words ", rivers or waters".

3. Anything done prior to the commencement of this Act validation in the purported exercise of the powers conferred by the provisions of the Principal Act as amended by section 2 of this Act, and which would have been lawful if this Act had been in force, shall, for all purposes, be deemed to have been lawfully and validly done under the Principal Act as amended by section 2.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend section 4 of the Shipping Casualties (Investigation and Prevention) Act, Cap. 49:07, for the purpose of enabling the appointment of a court of inquiry in respect of accidents involving vessels operating in inland rivers or navigable water of Guyana.
