AN ACT to amend the National Cane Farming Committee Act. Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Cap. 69:04.

This Act, which amends the National Cane Farming Short title. 1. Committee Act, may be cited as the National Cane Farming Committee (Amendment) Act 1979.

> Section 2 of the Principal Act is hereby amended — 2.

Amendment of section 2 of Principal Act.

- (a) by the substitution for the definition of "Association" of the following definition
 - ""Association" means any company or other organisation for the time being designated in writing by the Minister as being representative of persons who carry on the business of the manufacture of sugar;'; and
- (b) by the substitution for the definition of "Development
 - Corporation" of the following definition ""Development Corporation" means any company or other organisation for the time being designated in writing by the Minister as being concerned with undertaking, facilitating or promoting the development of the cane farming industry in Guyana;'.

3. Section 3(5) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the deletion of all the words following the words "members of the Committee". Amendment of section 3 of the Principal Act.

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Prior to its dissolution in 1978, the Guyana Sugar Producers' Association was a component unit of the machinery relating to the establishment and operations of the National Cane Farming Committee. In view of the dissolution of the Association, this Bill seeks to enable the Minister of Agriculture to substitute for the Association any other company or organisation which is representative of persons who are engaged in the business of manufacturing sugar.

For similar reasons a similar amendment is proposed in relation to the Cane Farming Development Corporation Limited. This body is now defunct.

Under the law as it stands the Chairman of the National Cane Farming Committee has to be a member of the Committee who is either a public officer or is employed by a public corporation established under any Act, while, the Vice-Chairman has to be a person who has been appointed a member of the Committee on the nomination of the Cane Farming Development Corporation Limited, or the Guyana Sugar Producers' Association (now dissolved). This Bill seeks to remove these restrictions and to enable the Chairman and the Vice-Chairman to be appointed from among the total membership of the Committee.
