### AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs (Amendment No. 3) Ordinance, 1959, and shall be construed and read with the Customs Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap. 309.

2. Part 1 of the first schedule to the Principal Ordinance (which as amended from time to time specifies the rates of import duties on certain articles shall be deemed to be amended, and to have been amended by the Customs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1959, from the commencement thereof, as if for the items in the schedule to the Customs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1959, referred to by number in the first column of the schedule to this Ordinance there had been substituted the respective items set forth in the second, third and fourth columns of the schedule to this Ordinance.

2. This Bill seeks to amend Part 1 of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance so as to remedy the effect thereon of certain errors in the schedule to the Customs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1959.
