Intituled

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE REGISTRATION OF CLUBS ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Clubs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1958, and shall be construed and read with the Registration of Clubs Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap. 321.

2. Section 24 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion after the words "Volunteer Force" of a comma and the words "Prison Officers".

Amendment of section 24 of Cap. 321.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to exempt any Prison Officers' Canteen or Mess from the provisions of the Registration of Clubs Ordinance prohibiting or restricting the sale or supply of intoxicating liquor. Naval, Military, Air Force, Volunteer Force and Police Canteens and Messes are already so exempt.
