AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE THE SUPPLIES GRANTED IN THE CURRENT SESSION OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

WHEREAS of the amount of forty-seven million, one hundred thousand, nine hundred and fifty-seven dollars required for the service of the Civil Government of British Guiana, and for other purposes, for the year commencing the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, the sum of four million, nine hundred and one thousand two hundred and ninety-four dollars has been provided for by law, and it is now requisite to make provision for the appropriation from the annual revenue of the year and other resources of British Guiana of forty-two million, one hundred and ninety-nine thousand, six hundred and sixty-three dollars :

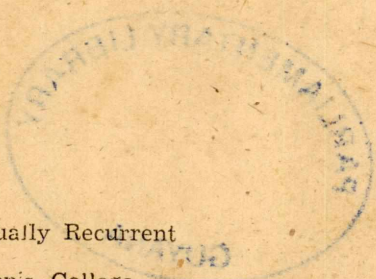
Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance, 1959. Short title.

2. The Accountant General shall, on the warrant of the Governor, pay from the annual revenue of the year, commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, and other resources of British Guiana a sum not exceeding in the aggregate forty-two million, one hundred and ninety-nine thousand, six hundred and sixty-three dollars as set forth in the schedule hereto for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Civil Government of British Guiana, and for other purposes during the said year. Accountant General to defray expenses of Civil Government.
