AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE NEW AMSTERDAM TOWN
COUNCIL ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the New Amsterdam Town Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, and shall be construed and read with the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

Cap. 161.

2. Section 88 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "five hundred dollars" of the words "seven hundred dollars".

Amendment of Section 88 of Chapter 161.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

Section 88 of the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, Chapter 161, authorises the sum of five hundred dollars from the funds of the Council to be placed annually at the personal disposal of the Mayor.

2. This amount which was fixed in 1949 is considered inadequate and the Bill seeks to increase this amount to seven hundred dollars.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE NEW AMSTERDAM TOWN COUNCIL ORDINANCE

Enacted by the Legislature of the State of New York

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, 1900, and shall be construed and read with the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, 1898, and the principal Ordinance of the Town of New Amsterdam, 1898, and all amendments thereto.

2. Section 88 of the principal Ordinance, 1898, is amended by substituting for the words "two hundred dollars" the words "one hundred dollars".

ENACTED AND PASSED

Section 88 of the New Amsterdam Town Council Ordinance, 1898, is amended by substituting the sum of one hundred dollars for the sum of two hundred dollars in the second sentence of the first paragraph of the said section.

3. The amendment which is contained in this Ordinance shall take effect on the first day of January next.

4. The Town Clerk is directed to cause a copy of this Ordinance to be printed and to be bound with the principal Ordinance of the Town of New Amsterdam, 1898, and all amendments thereto.
