PUBLIC CORPORATIONS (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1964.

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of section 2 of Ordinance No. 23 of 1962.

### A BILL

Intituled

An Ordinance to amend the Public Corporations Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

A.D. 1964.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Corporations (Amendment) Ordinance, 1964, and shall be construed and read as one with the Public Corporations Ordinance, 1962, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance and any Ordinance amending the same.

Short title.

No. 23 of 1962.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the definition of the expression "official member" of the following definition —

Amendment of section 2 of Ordinance No. 23 of 1962.

“official member” means a person in the public service so designated by a Minister.’

### OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to provide a new definition of the expression "official member" appearing in the Public Corporations Ordinance, 1962, to ensure that a person in the service of the Government of British Guiana may only be considered an official member if he is so designated by a Minister.
