AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE HOUSING OF LABOUR
WORKERS ON SUGAR ESTATES ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Housing of Labour Workers on Sugar Estates (Amendment) Ordinance, 1960, and shall be construed with the Housing of Labour Workers on Sugar Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Subsection (1) of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion after the words "approved site" appearing therein of the words "or to extend, improve or repair his own house on an approved site".

This Bill seeks to extend the special form of security provided by the Principal Ordinance for loans made by the Sugar Industry Labour Welfare Committee to sugar workers for the erection of their own houses, to loans for extensions, improvements and repairs to such houses.
