A BILL

Intituled

An Ordinance to regulate the publication of certain instruments in newspapers.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:-

A.D. 1964.

- 1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Statutory Publications Short title. Ordinance, 1964.
- Wherever under the provisions of any law there are references Publications requiring the publication of any order, notice, or any other instrument in whatsoever in more than one newspaper or daily newspaper, from and papers. after the commencement of this Ordinance the references aforesaid in any such law shall be construed and have effect as if there were substituted therefor references requiring the publication of any order, notice or any other instrument whatsoever to be made in only one newspaper.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of any law requiring the publication of tion of any order, notice, or any other instrument whatsoever in more certain publication one newspaper or daily newspaper, the publication before the commencement of this Ordinance of any order, notice or any other instrument whatsoever in only one newspaper or daily newspaper is hereby declared for all purposes to have been valid, proper and lawful.

OBJECTS AND REASONS

There are provisions of the law which require that certain orders, notices and other instruments be published in more than one newspaper or daily newspaper. It is considered desirable that such instruments should be published in only one newspaper and the purpose of this Bill is to provide accordingly.

2. Provision is also made to validate the publication of certain instruments in only one newspaper or daily newspaper in cases where the law required their publication in more than one newspaper or daily newspaper.
