A BILL

Intituled

AN ORDINANCE to amend the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:— A.D. 1962.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Pensions (Consolidation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1962, and shall be construed and read with the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the repeal of paragraph (a) of the definition of the expression "pensionable emoluments" and the substitution therefor of the following paragraph —

"(a) in respect of service in the Colony includes—

- (i) salary;
- (ii) personal allowance; and
- (iii) inducement allowance payable to an overseas officer under the Overseas Service Agreement Ordinance, 1961,

but does not include duty, entertainment or other allowance or any other emoluments whatsoever;"

OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill seeks to amend the Pensions (Consolidation) Ordinance, 1957, so that an inducement allowance payable to an overseas officer under the provisions of the Overseas Service Agreement Ordinance, 1961, will be regarded as pensionable emoluments.
