AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE GEORGETOWN TOWN COUNCIL ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:-

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as Cap. 152. the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same.

Section 138 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended—

(a) by the insertion after the words "the Ursuline convent and the land therewith occupied;" of the words "the convent of the Good Shepherd and the land therewith occupied;" and by the insertion after the words "British Guiana Nurses Association," of the words "of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals."

Amendment of section 138 of Chapter

Prevention of Cruelty to Animals,".

Commencement. 3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1957.

OBJECTS AND REASONS.

This bill seeks to exempt the convent of the Good Shepherd and the lands occupied with the convent and the land and the buildings of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals from municipal taxation with effect from 1st January, 1957.
