AN ORDINANCE FURTHER TO AMEND THE GEORGETOWN
TOWN COUNCIL ORDINANCE.

Enacted by the Legislature of British Guiana:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Georgetown Town Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 1957, and shall be construed and read as one with the Georgetown Town Council Ordinance, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance, and any Ordinance amending the same. Short title,
Cap. 152.
2. Section 138 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended— Amendment
of section 138
of Chapter
152.
 - (a) by the insertion after the words "the Ursuline convent and the land therewith occupied;" of the words "the convent of the Good Shepherd and the land therewith occupied;" and
 - (b) by the insertion after the words "British Guiana Nurses Association," of the words "of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals,".

Commence-
ment.

3. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1957.

OBJECTS AND REASONS.

This bill seeks to exempt the convent of the Good Shepherd and the lands occupied with the convent and the land and the buildings of the Royal Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals from municipal taxation with effect from 1st January, 1957.
