**NATIONAL ACCREDITATION COUNCIL ACT 2004 (VALIDATION) BILL 2019**

**A BILL****Intituled**

**AN ACT** to validate the commencement of and all acts and things done under the National Accreditation Council Act 2004.

A.D. 2019 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title.                    **1.** This Act, which validates the commencement of and all acts and things done under the National Accreditation Council Act 2004 since 2004, No.12 of 2004 may be cited as the National Accreditation Council Act 2004 (Validation) Act 2019.

Commencement of National Accreditation Council Act 2004. No.12 of 2004                    **2.** The National Accreditation Council Act 2004 shall be deemed to have come into operation on 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2004.

Validation of acts.                    **3.** All acts and things done between 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2004 and the date of the commencement of this Act which would have been lawful if the National Accreditation Council Act 2004 had been brought in force by order published in the *Gazette* shall for all purposes be deemed to be and always to have been lawfully and validly done and all persons are freed, acquitted, discharged and indemnified from all liability and legal proceedings of any kind in respect of those acts and things. 4. No person shall be held guilty of a criminal offence on account of any act or omission and no person shall be made or shall become liable to any penalty whatsoever in respect of any act of commission or omission under the National Accreditation Council Act 2004 between 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2004 and the commencement of this Act.

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

This Bill seeks to validate the commencement of and all acts and things done under the National Accreditation Council Act 2004 with effect from 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2004. It validates all acts and things done between 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2004 and the commencement of this Act which would have been lawful if the National Accreditation Council Act had been brought in force by order published in the *Gazette*. All persons are freed, acquitted, discharged and indemnified from all liability and legal proceedings of any kind in respect of all acts and things done between 30<sup>th</sup> July, 2004 and the commencement of this Act. In addition, no person shall be held guilty of a criminal offence on account of any act or omission under the National Accreditation Council Act.
