## RULES

MADE UNDER

THE DEEDS REGISTRY ORDINANCE  
 (Chapter 32)

IN PURSUANCE OF RULE 8 OF THE DEEDS REGISTRY RULES AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING US IN THAT BEHALF, WE, EDWARD VICTOR LUCKHOO, CHANCELLOR, HAROLD BRODIE SMITH BOLLERS, CHIEF JUSTICE, VICTOR EMANUEL CRANE, JUSTICE OF APPEAL, KENNETH MONTAGUE GEORGE, PUISNE JUDGE, KENNETH WYNDHAM BARNWELL, REGISTRAR OF THE SUPREME COURT OF JUDICATURE, JOSEPH OSCAR FITZCLARENCE HAYNES, SENIOR COUNSEL AND MAURICE ERIC CLARKE, SOLICITOR, CONSTITUTING THE RULES COMMITTEE UNDER SECTION 75 OF THE HIGH COURT ORDINANCE, DO HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING RULES—

1. (1) These Rules may be cited as the Rules of the High Court (Deeds Registry) 1970, and amend the Rules of the High Court (Deeds Registry), hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules.

(2) These Rules shall come into operation forthwith.

2. The following paragraph is hereby substituted for paragraph (1) of rule 2 of the Principal Rules—

“(1) The time for entering opposition to the passing of a transport, mortgage or lease shall expire at three o'clock in the afternoon of the thirteenth day after the advertisement of the transport, mortgage or lease in the Gazette.”
