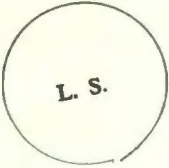

INSTRUMENT APPOINTING A MINISTER

WHEREAS it is provided by paragraph (4) of article 34 of the Constitution of Guyana that the Ministers, other than the Prime Minister, shall be appointed by the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, from among persons who are elected members of the National Assembly or are qualified to be elected as such members;

AND WHEREAS Marcellus Feilden Singh Esquire, Barrister-at-law, is an elected member of the National Assembly:

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of paragraph (4) of article 34 of the Constitution of Guyana, and in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, I do hereby appoint the said Marcellus Feilden Singh to be a Minister.
