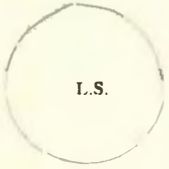

PROCLAMATION



By His Excellency SIR DAVID JAMES GARDINER ROSE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander in the Royal Victorian Order, Member of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Guyana.

WHEREAS by section 4(1) of the Roads Ordinance, Chapter 277, it is provided that the Governor-General may, from time to time by proclamation published in the Gazette, declare that any road not mentioned in the schedule to the said Ordinance shall be maintained, or constructed and maintained, out of moneys provided by Parliament, and thereupon the provisions of the said Ordinance shall apply to such road in the same manner as if it had been mentioned in the said schedule;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient that the road specified in the schedule hereto should be maintained out of moneys provided by Parliament;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power in me vested by section 4(1) of the Roads Ordinance, Chapter 277, and of all other powers thereunto enabling me, I do hereby declare that the road specified in the schedule hereto shall be maintained out of moneys provided by Parliament.

SCHEDULE

East Bank Demerara River

The road known as the Atkinson Field/Mackenzie Highway from its junction with the East Bank Public Road at Soesdyke to its junction with the road at Kara Kara north east of Rainbow City as shown on plans of Project No. 44 Sections IA, I, II, III, IV, V and VII prepared by the Roads Division of the Ministry of Works and Hydraulics.

Given under my Hand and the Public Seal of Guyana at Guyana House, Georgetown this 27th day of November, 1968, and in the seventeenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
