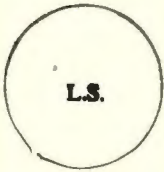

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency, **SIR DAVID JAMES GARDINER ROSE**, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander in the Royal Victorian Order, Member of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Guyana.

WHEREAS it is provided by Article 67 of the Constitution of Guyana that an election of members of the National Assembly shall be held on such day within three months after every dissolution of Parliament as the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, shall appoint by proclamation;

AND WHEREAS by proclamation of the Governor-General dated 4th November, 1968, Parliament shall be dissolved on 5th November, 1968:

NOW, THEREFORE, in pursuance of the said Article 67, I do hereby appoint 16th December, 1968, as the day on which an election of members of the National Assembly shall be held.

Given under my Hand and the Public Seal of Guyana at Guyana House, Georgetown, this 4th day of November, 1968, and in the seventeenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
