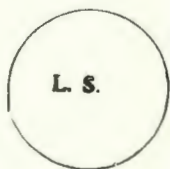

## PROCLAMATION



By His Excellency SIR DAVID JAMES GARDINER ROSE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Commander in the Royal Victorian Order, Member of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Guyana.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 3(1) of the Forest Ordinance, as it has effect by virtue of section 5(1) of the Guyana Independence Order, 1966, that the Governor-General may, by proclamation published in the Gazette, declare any area of crown land to be a crown forest;

AND WHEREAS it is provided by section 3(2) of the aforesaid Ordinance that each proclamation declaring any area of crown land to be a crown forest shall exclude all land owned by any person in such area;

NOW, THEREFORE, acting in accordance with the aforesaid provisions and by virtue and in exercise of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I do hereby declare the area of crown land described in the schedule hereto to be crown forest.

Given under my Hand and the Public Seal of Guyana at Guyana House, Georgetown, this 14th day of March 1969, and in the eighteenth year of Her Majesty's Reign.

### SCHEDULE

That part of Guyana bounded as follows:—

Commencing at the confluence of the Mahaica and the Maduni Rivers and extending up the right bank of the Maduni River to its source, thence by a line to the source of the Kuru Kuru Creek, a branch of the Hauraruni on the right bank of the Demerara River, thence down the left bank of the Kuru Kuru Creek to a point about one and a half miles above its junction with the Atkinson-Mackenzie Highway, thence in a southerly direction by a line parallel to and one mile east of the Atkinson-Mackenzie Highway to the Mobilissa River at a point about one and a half miles above its junction with the Atkinson-Mackenzie Highway, thence up the right bank of the Mobilissa River to its source, thence by a line eastwards to the left bank of the Mahaica River thence down the left bank of the Mahaica River to the point of commencement, except all lands owned by persons in the area of crown land hereinbefore described in this schedule.
