PROCLAMATION



By His Excellency EDWARD VICTOR LUCKHOO, Esq., acting Governor-General of Guyana.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 11 of the Income Tax Ordinance Chapter 299, that the Governor-General may, by proclamation published in the Gazette, provide that the interest payable on any loan charged on the consolidated Fund shall be exempted from tax either generally or only in respect of interest payable to persons not resident in Guyana, and that such interest as from the date and to the extent specified in the proclamation shall be exempt accordingly:

NOW, THEREFORE, acting under the aforementioned provision and by virtue and in exercise of all powers enabling me in that behalf, I do hereby declare and provide that the interest on any Government of Guyana debentures held by persons not resident in Guyana and issued in connection with any loan raised under the authority of the Public Loan Ordinance, 1966, shall from the date of issue of such debentures be exempted from income tax.
