AN ACT to amend the Local Authorities (Elections) Act to provide for the postponement of elections of councillors of local democratic organs.


1. This Act, which amends the Local Authorities (Elections) Act, may be cited as the Local Authorities (Elections) (Amendment) Act 2008 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1<sup>st</sup> November, 2008,

2. Section 36A (1) of the Principal Act is amended by the substitution for the words "eleven years" of the words "twelve years", and this amendment shall apply only to the next local government elections to elect members of local democratic organs now to be held on or before 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2009 in consequence of this amendment.

**EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM**

This Bill seeks to extend the date on which local government elections may be held.
