- Short title. 1. This Act, which amends the Export and Import (Specia No. 8 of 1986 Provisions) Act 1986, may be cited as the Export and Impor (Special Provisions) (Amendment) Act 1986.
- Amendment 9 Section 9 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by of the Principal hat insertion, after subsection (4), of the following subsection pal Act. (5)
 - "(5) Without prejudice to the provisions of subsectio (4), the Minister may by notification in the *Gazett* exempt, subject to such conditions as he may specify consignments of any class of goods, or consignment to any class of persons, from the provisions of su sections (1), (2) and (3)."

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend section 9 of the Export and Import (Special Provisions) Act 1986 (Act No. 8 of 1986) so as to empower the Minister to exempt consignments of any class of goods or consignments to any class of persons from the provisions of that section dealing with legalisation of shipping documents.
