AN ACT to amend the National Insurance and Social Security Act.

- A.D. 1989 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-
- Short title. 1. This Act, which amends the National Insurance and Social Security Act, may be cited as the National Insurance and Social Security (Amendment) Act 1989.

Amendment 2. The Principal Act is hereby amended in the following cipal Act, respects —

- (a) in section 2, by the deletion of the definitions of the expressions "contribution card" and "insurance stamp";
- (b) in section 17
 - (i) by the deletion of subsection (2);
 - (ii) by the substitution, in subsection (3), for the words "insurance stamps" wherever they occur of the words "cash or cheque";
- (c) in section 19 (1) (a) (v), by the insertion after the words "that is to say," of the words "a payment or";
- (d) in section 41, by the deletion of subsections (4) (a) and (4) (b);
- (e) in section 43
 - (i) by the deletion of subsection (2);
 - (ii) by the deletion of the words "or (2)" in subsections (3) and (4);
 - (iii) by the deletion of the words "or subsection 2" in subsection (5).

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to amend certain provisions of the National Insurance and Social Security Act for the purpose of abolishing the system whereby payments of contributions are effected by means of insurance stamps.
