Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:---

Short title 1. (1) This Act, which amends the Employment of Women, and con-Young Persons and Children Act, may be cited as the Employ- can. 99:0 Cap. 99:01 ment of Young Persons and Children (Amendment) Act 1983.

(2) As from the commencement of this Act, the Principal Act may be cited as the Employment of Young Persons and Children Act, and section 1 of the Principal Act and all other laws wherein the Principal Act is mentioned shall have effect accordingly.
