A BILL

Intituled

An Act to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sum necessary to meet the expenditure (not otherwise lawfully charged on the Consolidated Fund) of Guyana for the year ending 31st December, 1970, estimates whereof have been approved by the National Assembly, and for appropriation of that sum for specified purposes, in conformity with the Constitution of Guyana.

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title.

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1970.
- Issue from the Consolidated Fund authorised.
- 2. The Accountant General may, on the warrant of the Minister, issue from the Consolidated Fund a sum not exceeding in the aggregate the gross amount of one hundred and seventy-seven million, one hundred and forty-nine thousand, eight hundred and fifty-six dollars for defraying the several charges and expenses of the Government and for other purposes for the financial year ending on the 31st December, 1970, and before that date the appropriate Accounting Officers shall pay in to the Accountant General for deposit into the Consolidated Fund, the sums totalling three million, seven hundred and one thousand, seven hundred and ninety-eight dollars shown as appropriations-in-aid in the last column of the schedule to this Act, thereby making the issues from the Consolidated Fund to meet expenditure for the financial year, not exceeding in the aggregate the net sum of one hundred and seventy-three million, four hundred

Appropriations Schedule.

3. The net sum granted in section 2 of this Act is hereby appropriate for the services and purposes expressed in the schedule to this appropriate to and in accordance with paragraph (2) of Article 11 of the Constitution of Guyana and shall be deemed to have been a uthorised from 1st day of January, 1970.
