SEA DEFENCE (AMENDMENT) BILL 1972

A BILL

Intituled

AN ACT to amend the Sea Defence Ordinance

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Sea Defence (Amendment) Short Title Act 1972 and amends the Sea Defence Ordinance, hereinafter re- Cap. 191ferred to as the Principal Ordinance.
2. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended Amendment in the following respects — of section 4
 - (a) by the substitution of the words "less than fourteen" of Chapter for the words "more than eleven" in subsection (1); 191. and
 - (b) by the insertion of the words "or such greater number as may be fixed by the Minister" immediately after the word "meeting" in subsection (6).

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill seeks to make provision for the amendment of the Sea Defence Ordinance (Chapter 191) for the purpose of increasing the membership of the Sea Defence Board which is charged with the statutory duty of maintaining, managing and constructing the sea defences of Guyana.
