

REGULATIONS

Made Under

THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT

(Cap. 47:01)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 97 OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS ARE HEREBY MADE:—

1. These Regulations which amend the Telex and Telephone (Overseas Fees) Regulations 1977\* may be cited as the Telex and Telephone (Overseas Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1978. Citation.
2. These Regulations shall come into operation forthwith. Commencement.
3. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended in the following respects — Amendment of the Principal Regulations.

- (a) by the insertion immediately after Regulation 2 of the following Regulation as Regulation 3 —

“(3). Notwithstanding anything to the contrary set out in the Schedule, where an overseas telephone call is chargeable to a telephone service provided outside of Zone 1, there shall be charged in respect of each minute of that call, in addition to the amount specified in the Schedule, a fee of 60 cents.”;

- (b) by the insertion immediately after Part B of the Schedule of the following definitions —

“Zone 1” means the Georgetown area;

“Zone 2” means any area of Guyana outside the Georgetown area;

“Georgetown area” means the area bounded on the East by the University of Guyana Road — approximately 4 miles; on the West by Water Street; on the North by the Atlantic Ocean; and on the South by the Providence Canal north side — approximately 4.75 miles.
