

## ORDER

Made Under

THE MINISTERS, MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY  
AND SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS) ORDINANCE 1965.

(No. 7 of 1965)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY  
SECTION 8 OF THE MINISTERS, MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE  
OF ASSEMBLY AND SPECIAL OFFICES (EMOLUMENTS)  
ORDINANCE 1965, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER: -

1. This Order may be cited as the Ministers,  
Members of the National Assembly and Special Offices  
(Emoluments) (No. 3) Order 1973, and shall be deemed  
to have come into operation on 1st July, 1973.

2. The schedule to the Ministers, Members of  
the National Assembly and Special Offices (Emolu-  
ments) (No. 2) Order 1973 is hereby amended by the  
insertion of the following words at the commencement  
of the provisions of that schedule -

"1. The persons holding the respective  
offices specified hereunder shall be  
paid salaries at the respective rates  
specified hereunder in respect of the  
said offices - "


3. The schedule to the Ordinance is hereby  
amended by the addition thereto of the following  
paragraph as paragraph 6 -

"6. There shall be paid to every Minister and the Attorney-General an allowance to be paid by him as a gratuity to his chauffeur calculated at the rate of twenty-two and one-half per cent of the basic salary (determined by the Minister responsible for finance) paid to the chauffeur for each completed month of employment, payable either at intervals of six months or at the termination of the employment of the chauffeur:

Provided that no such allowance shall be paid unless the Minister or the Attorney-General, as the case may be, certifies that the chauffeur has discharged his duties satisfactorily."
