AGREEMENT

The Government of Guyana (hereinafter referred to as "the Government") of the one part, and the Guyana Public Service Association, the Federated Union of Government Employees, the Clerical and Commercial Workers' Union, the Guyana Labour Union, the Pilots' Association and the Guyana Teachers' Association, of the other part (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Unions") hereby enter into this Agreement this 30th day of June, 1973.

ARTICLE 1

MINIMUM WAGE

It is hereby agreed that the minimum daily wage rate payable by the Government shall be five dollars and fifty cents (\$5.50) with effect from 1st January, 1973.

ARTICLE 2

IMPLEMENTATION OF REVISED SILARY SCALES AND WAGE RATES

- 1. The revised salary scales and wage rates negotiated between the Government and the Unions and as set out in the Scalar to this Agreement shall be implemented with effect from 1st January, 1973.
- 2. The salaries of those employees of the Government (to whom the revised salary scales are applicable) who were employed by the Government prior to 1st January 1973 and who continued to be so employed at 1st January, 1973, shall be payable in accordance with the following principles:
 - every such employee shall convert as at 1st January, 1973, to the nearest higher point in the particular revised salary scale applicable to him having regard to his present salary and to such amouts as may have been payable. to him as interim relief payments and, in the case of teachers, those allowances which form part of their pensionable emoluments, provided that where such conversion would not result in the award of the equivalent of at least two increments in the particular salary scale, such employee shall convert instead to such higher point in that salary scale as shall result in the award of the equivalent of less than three but not less than two increments in the salary scale;

- (b) the incremental date of every such employee shall be 1st January.
- 3. The emoluments of those employees of the Government (to whom the revised salary scales and wage rates are applicable) who commenced employment with the Government on or after 1st January, 1973 shall be payable, as from the commencement of such employment, in accordance with the revised salary scales and wage rates set out in the Schedule to this Agreement.
- 4. Without prejudice to the taking into account of other allowances for the purposes of the application of the foregoing provisions of this article, the amounts paid to persons in the employment of the Government as interim relief payments shall be taken into account.

ARTICLE 3

RETROACTIVE PLYMENTS

- 1. In addition to the amounts payable to employees of the Government as arrears of salary by virtue of the application of the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 2, there shall be paid as arrears of salary to every such employee of the Government a commuted amount equivalent to ten (10) per cent of the emoluments received by the employee in respect of 1972.
- 2. There shall be paid to every person who was formerly employed by the Government and who retired from the service of the Government during 1972, a commuted amount of ten (10) per cent of the emoluments received by that person in 1972 in respect of the period of his service before the effective date of his retirement.
- 3. In this Article, "emoluments" means salary, interim relief payments, personal pensionable allowances, surcharge allowances paid to pilots, departmental allowances paid to officers in the Inland Revenue Department of or above the grade of Inspector of Taxes and those allowances paid to teachers which form part of their pensionable emoluments.

ARTICLE 4

INCOME TAX IN RESPECT OF RETROACTIVE

PAYMENTS.

1. The commuted payment mentioned in paragraph 1 of Article 3 shall be treated as if it were income earned evenly over the period of five years expiring on 31st December, 1973, or the period of the actual service of the employee if it is shorter than the first-mentioned period, and income tax shall be payable thereon on the making of an assessment on the employee by the Commissioner of Inland Revenue.

2.1 Income tax on the retroactive payments for 1973 shall be payable in 1973.

ARTICLE 5

INTERIM RELIEF PAYMENTS PENSIONABLE

Amounts paid to employees of the Government as interim relief payments in respect of the period ending 31st December 1972 shall form part of thier pensionable emoluments in respect of that period.

ARTICLE 6

REVISION OF PENSIONS

The Government undertakes to revise the pensions now paid to former employees of the Government.

ARTICLE 7

INTERPRETATION

In this Agreement, the expression "Employees of the Government" includes teachers in Aidsd (Primary) schools within the meaning of the Education Ordinance (Chapter 91).

ARTICLE 8

CLASSIFICATION APPEALS

- In respect of employees of the Government, other than those represented by the Guyana Teachers' association, interim appeal procedures will be established for the purpose of hearing classification appeals erising out of the installation of the new classification plan for the public service.
- 2. Where such an appeal is allowed, the decision shall take sffect from the 1st January, 1973.

ARTICLE 9

This Agreement shall continue in force until the 31st December, 1976, but pending the negotiation and conclusion of a new Agreement which shall take effect from 1st January, 1977, the provisions of this Agreement shall continue in full force and effect.
