THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ORDINANCE
1962

(No. 26 of 1962)

IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON ME BY SECTION 3 OF THE CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (REMUNERATION OF HOLDERS) ORDINANCE 1962, I HEREBY MADE THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) Order 1973, and amends the Constitutional Offices (Holders' Allowances) Order 1963.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1973.

2. The Principal Order is hereby amended in the following respects -

- (a) by the substitution of the words "twelve thousand" for the words "nine thousand six hundred" in clause 3;
- (b) by the substitution of the words "twelve thousand" for the words "four thousand eight hundred" in clause 3;
- (c) by the addition immediately after clause 3, of the following clause as clause 3A -

"Duty Allowances 3A.

The persons holding the respective offices specified hereunder shall be paid duty allowances at the rates specified hereunder in respect of the said offices -

The Chancellor \$4,800 per annum

The Chief Justice \$3,600 per annum

Every Justice of Appeal
the Ombudsman and the
Director of Public
Prosecutions \$3,000 per annum

Every Puisne
Judge \$2,400 per annum";

- (d) by the substitution of the words "sixty-five dollars" for the words "thirty-six dollars and twenty cents" in clause 4;

- (e) by the substitution of the following clause for clause 7 -

Entertainment Allowance 7. The persons holding the respective offices specified hereunder shall be paid entertainment allowances at the rates specified hereunder in respect of the said offices -

The Chancellor	\$250 per month
The Chief Justice	\$200 per month
Every Justice of Appeal, the Ombudsman, the Director of Public Prosecutions and every Puisne Judge	\$100 per month"; and

- (f) by the addition of the words "and fifty" immediately after the word "hundred" in clause 9.
