IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 16
OF THE POST AND TELEGRAPH ACT, I HEREBY ORDER AS FOLLOWS:-

Citation.

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Rates of Postage
(Surface Mail and Fees for Services) Order 1974.

(2) This Order shall come into operation on 1st July, 1974.

2. (1) The rates of postage to be paid in respect of the
communications and postal packets specified in column 1 of the
First Schedule when addressed to places within Guyana shall be
those specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

(2) The rates of postage to be paid in respect of the
communications and postal packets specified in column 1 of the
First Schedule when addressed to places outside Guyana shall be
those specified in column 3 of that Schedule.

3. (1) The fees to be paid for the services specified in
column 1 of the Second Schedule when those services are required
in relation to places within Guyana shall be those specified
in column 2 of that Schedule.

(2) The fees to be paid for the services specified in the
first column of the Second Schedule when those services are
required in relation to places outside Guyana shall be those set
out in column 3 of that Schedule.
