THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE

(CHAPTER 309)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL AS FOLLOWS :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) (No. 6) Order, 1967.

2. Part III of the First Schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the addition of the following paragraph to item 27 —

“17. Chemicals when imported for use in the printing of colour film by a printer of colour film provided the Comptroller is satisfied that such chemicals will be used solely for that purpose.

For the purpose of this item “printing” includes processing and the expression “printer” shall be construed accordingly.”
