THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ORDINANCE, 1962,
(No. 23 of 1962).

UNDER SECTION 43 OF THE PUBLIC CORPORATIONS ORDINANCE, 1962, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS HEREUNTO ENABLING THE FOLLOWING ORDER HAS BEEN MADE BY THE CABINET :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Guyana Telecommunication Corporation (Exemption of Import Duty) Order, 1968.

2. The Guyana Telecommunication Corporation are hereby exempt from liability for import duty in respect of any telecommunications equipment and plant, including vehicles, imported for use by them in their capital expansion works.
