REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE NATIONAL REGISTRATION ACT, 1967.

(No. 24 of 1967).

UNDER SECTION 19 OF THE NATIONAL REGISTRATION ACT, 1967, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE MINISTER :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Registration (Residents) (Amendment) Regulations, 1968, and shall be read and construed as one with the National Registration (Residents) Regulations, 1967, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 6 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution —

- (a) for the word “by” in sub-paragraph (a) of paragraph (2), of the words “for the purposes of completion of”;
- (b) for the word “by” in sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (3), of the words “on the part of”;
- (c) for the words “show him to be qualified” in paragraph (3), of the words “are such as to qualify him for electoral registration”.

3. Sub-paragraph (e) of paragraph (1) of regulation 50 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the word “section” therein of the word “regulation”.
