## THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT

(Cap. 51:02)

IN THE EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON THE MINISTER BY SECTION 104 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, I MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:-

Citation

1. These Regulations, which amend the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Regulations\*, may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations 2013.

Amendment of regulation 33 of the Principal Regulations.

2. Regulation 33 of the Principal Regulations is amended by the substitution therefor the following regulation-

\*Qualifications for hire car, motor bus and goods vehicle licence.

33. A person who desires to obtain a licence other than a previous holder thereof unless the prescribed authority otherwise directs in any particular case) to drive a hire car, motor bus or goods vehicles must be-

(a) at least twenty-one years of age;

(b) capable of reading and writing English;

(c) the holder of-


(i) a licence issued under section 29 for the minimum period of two years; or

(ii) in respect of a re-migrant, a licence issued under section 29 together with a valid driving licence and a licence for the class of vehicle that the applicant desires to obtain, both issued by the competent authority of a country other than Guyana; and

(d) submit a statement signed by a licensing officer to the effect that the applicant has been successful in the examination as to the provisions of the Act relating to traffic.”.
