REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE SPIRITS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 319)

UNDER SECTION 128 OF THE SPIRITS ORDINANCE AND BY VIRTUE
AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL OTHER POWERS ENABLING HIM IN
THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN
MADE BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Spirits (Amendment) Regulations, 1968, and shall be construed and read as one with the Regulations made under the Spirits Ordinance on the 3rd October, 1905,* hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion immediately after regulation 17 thereof, of the following regulation —

“17A. Where the capacity of a package exceeds 150 gallons and the content capacity thereof cannot be computed by the method provided in the foregoing regulations, such computation may be ascertained in a manner approved by the Comptroller.”
