REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE TIMEHRI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ORDINANCE
(Chapter 282)

UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE TIMEHRI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT ORDINANCE, I HEREBY MAKE THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS—

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Timehri International Airport (Amendment) Regulations, 1969, and shall be construed and read as one with the Timehri International Airport Regulations, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and all amendments thereto.

(2) These Regulations shall come into operation forthwith.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following regulation as regulation 25 —

“Consumption
of malt and
spirituous
liquor at the
Airport.”

25. (1) Except with the approval of the Director or where it forms part of the luggage of a passenger, no malt or spirituous liquor shall be taken into the Terminal Building at the Airport by any person.

(2) No person shall consume any malt or spirituous liquor—

(a) in the Terminal Building at the Airport except in the dining room, the public bars or in such other places as may be approved by the Director;

(b) outside the Terminal Building at the Airport within a radius of one hundred yards thereof.”
