

REGULATIONS

MADE UNDER

THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,

(Chapter 280).

UNDER SECTION 35(4) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC

ORDINANCE, THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS HAS MADE

THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS:-

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1970, and shall come into operation forthwith.

2. The Second Schedule to the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects -

- (a) by the insertion immediately before item 5, appearing under the heading "Limit of Speed", of the following proviso -

"Provided that the maximum speed per hour for a vehicle under the control of a holder of a provisional licence, being a vehicle of a class mentioned in the foregoing items numbered 1 and 2 shall be 30 miles, and 25 miles, respectively".

- (b) by the substitution for paragraphs (a) and (b), relating to the definitions of "the City of Georgetown" and "the town of New Amsterdam" of the following paragraphs respectively -

'(a) "the city of Georgetown" means the City of Georgetown as defined for the purposes of the Municipal and District Councils Act, 1969;

(b) "the town of New Amsterdam" means the Town of New Amsterdam as defined for the purposes of the Municipal and District Councils, Act, 1969;'
