## REGULATIONS

## MADE UNDER

## THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.

(Chapter 280).

UNDER SECTION 35(4) OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC

ORDINANCE, THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATIONS HAS MADE

## THE FOLIOWING REGULATIONS:-

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations, 1970, and shall come into operation forthwith.
- 2. The Second Schedule to the Motor Vehicles and Road
  Traffic Ordinance is hereby amended in the following respects -
  - (a) by the insertion immediately before item 5,
     appearing under the heading "Limit of Speed",
     of the following proviso -

"Provided that the maximum speed per hour for a vehicle under the control of a holder of a provisional licence, being a vehicle of a class mentioned in the foregoing items numbered 1 and 2 shall be 30 miles, and partial will in the provisional licence.

- (b) by the substitution for paragraphs (a) and (b), relating to the definitions of "the City of Georgetown" and "the town of New Amsterdam" of the following paragraphs respectively -
  - '(a) "the city of Georgetown" means the City
    of Georgetown as defined for the purposes
    of the Municipal and District Councils Act,
    1969;
  - (b) "the town of New Amsterdam" means the Town of New Amsterdam as defined for the purposes of the Municipal and District Councils, Act, 1969;'.
