

BRITISH GUIANA

ORDER IN COUNCIL
Made Under
THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE IT IS HEREBY
ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Order, 1960.

2. Part III of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance as amended from time to time is hereby further amended by the addition of the following item —

“ 65. Goods imported for his personal use or the personal use of his family by a member of any organisation or agency engaged on a technical assistance mission in British Guiana where and to the extent that the agreement relating to such technical assistance so provides.”
