ORDER IN COUNCIL  
Made Under  
THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE,  
(Chapter 309).

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IT IS HEREBY  
ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:—

Part III of the first schedule to the Customs Ordinance, as amended from time to time, is hereby further amended by the addition after the proviso to Item 11 of the following paragraph —

“Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this Item, prune wine and blending sherry when imported for use in the manufacture of rum in bonded premises shall be exempt from import duty.”
