The sum to be inserted in the Preamble to the Bill as the gross amount required for the service of the Civil Government and for other purposes for the year 1960 is \$50,462,418 and the total amount to be appropriated which has also to be inserted in the Preamble and in Clause 2 of the Bill is \$45,104,252. The amount to be shown as provided by Law is \$5,358,166.
