THE PUBLIC AND JUDICIAL OFFICERS (REMUNERATION)
ORDINANCE, 1962.

UNDER SECTION 5 OF THE PUBLIC AND JUDICIAL OFFICERS
(REMUNERATION) ORDINANCE, 1962, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED
BY THE MINISTER OF FINANCE AS FOLLOWS :—

1.(1) This Order may be cited as the Public and Judicial Officers (Remuneration) Order 1963.

(2) This Order shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January, 1961.

2. In this Order —

“the Ordinance” means the Public and Judicial Officers (Remuneration) Ordinance, 1962.*

3. The schedule to the Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the symbol and figures “\$10,080” appearing as salary in respect of the office of Director of Audit, of the symbol and figures “\$10,320”.
