## THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE

(Chapter 309).

- UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE CUSTOMS ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—
- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment No. 4) Order, 1962.
- 2 Part I of the First Schedule to T e Customs Ordinance as amended from time to time is hereby further amended by
  - (:) the substitution of the rates of import duty set forth in the third column again the articles numbered and described in the first and second columns of the First Schedule to this Order for the rates of import duty set against the corresponding articles numbered and described in the said Part I;
  - (b) the deletion therefrom of the items set forth in the first, second, third and fourth columns of the Second Schedule to this Order:
  - (c) the insertion of the items set forth in the first, second, third and fourth columns of the Third Schedule to this Order;
  - (d) the substitution of he figures "6.00" for the figures "12.00" wherever they appear in the proviso immediately before the table of Export Duties.
