THE LABOUR ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 103)

UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE LABOUR ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE GOVERNOR AS FOLLOWS:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Minimum Wages (Saw Mill Workers) (Revocation) Order, 1962.
2. The Minimum Wages (Saw Mill Workers) Order in Council 1956* is hereby revoked.
