THE ELECTORAL PROVISIONS (REGISTRATION)  
ORDINANCE, 1961,  
(No. 10 of 1961).

UNDER SECTION 23 OF THE ELECTORAL PROVISIONS  
(REGISTRATION) ORDINANCE, 1961, AND BY VIRTUE  
OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF,  
THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY  
THE GOVERNOR :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Electoral Provisions (Registration) (Amendment) Regulations, 1961, and shall be read and construed with the Electoral Provisions (Registration) Regulations, 1961, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The second proviso to paragraph (3) of regulation 6 of the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "one journey" of the words "two journeys".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This is not part of the Regulations, but is intended to indicate their general purport).

The Electoral Provisions (Registration) Regulations, 1961, hitherto entitled an enumerator to a travelling allowance for a single journey to and from the place where he receives his instructions for the purpose of the compilation of any register of electors. These Regulations have amended the law to entitle him to travelling allowances for two such journeys.
