Made Under

**THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,
(Chapter 280).**

UNDER SECTION 103 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH (1) OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1962, and shall be construed and read as one with the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Regulations*, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Regulations, and any Regulations amending the same.

2. The Principal Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after regulation 90 of the following new regulation —

“90A. Notwithstanding the provisions of regulations 89 and 90 of these Regulations, the Licensing Authority may approve of the dimensions of a trailer being in excess of those specified therein, subject to such conditions as he may think fit.”
