THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE

(Chapter 280)

UNDER SUB-SECTION 3 OF SECTION 98 OF THE MOTOR VEHICLES AND ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, IN ACCORDANCE WITH PARAGRAPH 1 OF ARTICLE 22 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF BRITISH GUIANA, AND BY VIRTUE AND IN EXERCISE OF ALL POWERS ENABLING HIM IN THAT BEHALF, THE FOLLOWING REGULATIONS HAVE BEEN MADE BY THE GOVERNOR:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1962.

2. Part B of the First Schedule to the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution for the figures “1.00” appearing opposite the words and figures “Section 29. For driver’s licence” of the figures “3.00”. Cap. 280.
